The Origins of the TIDEWATER BIG TRAIN OPERATORS CLUB

Preface

As this club is approaching its thirtieth Anniversary, I thought that it would be appropriate to let our newer members know just how this club came into existence. Since there is only one original member still on the roster, I have had to rely on memories and early Gulls to put this story together. Thanks to Faye Stewart and Alice Maisey for providing copies of the early Gulls.

Background

In the early 1960's the Lehman Toy Company, in Germany, decided to add a new toy ine for children. They decided to make an electric operated train, but did not want to compete with the "HO" and "O" gauge trains that were plentiful on the market. They decided to use Gauge 1 for track size and from that they developed the iconic 0-4-0 engine based on a narrow gauge engine used in Europe. The first train sets were produced in 1968 and were intended for the European market.. However, American importers began buying these starter sets for distribution in the United States. Among these importers was Arthur "Junie" Lancaster, then owner of Coleman's Nursery in Portsmouth, Virginia. Sales of LGB train sets expanded so rapidly in the US that soon clubs began to form especially on the East Coast. Junie Lancaster sold the Nursery and opened a new business in Suffolk. It was on the sight of this business That Mike Twiford moved his Mikes Trainland Shop from Coleman's to the corner of Bridge Road and Shoulders Hill Road. It was

1979 that the first Annual Convention of the L.G.B. Big Train Operator's Clubs was held. The fourth Annual Convention was hosted by Mike Twiford and Junie Lancaster at Coleman's Nursery August 9 – 12, 1982. At this convention, Bob Stewart and 15 other residents of this area joined the L.G.B. B.T.O. club. The fifth convention, 1983, was held in Strasburg, PA and the sixth (1984) was held in Chicago, IL.

The seventh convention returned to Virginia and was held at Mike's Trainland in Suffolk in 1985. At this convention, Bob Stewart applied for permission to form a local Tidewater Chapter. Permission was granted and the very first meeting of The Tidewater Big Train Operators Club was held on September 24, 1985 at Mike's Trainland. The original nine members were:

Even though the first meeting was held in September, 1985, a hand written roster lists the membership date of the above nine founders as November, 1985. This is explained because in those early

years, meetings were held only every other month. The first meeting was strictly organizational and the November meeting the first official meeting.

In December, 1985 four new members were added. They were:

In Jan. 1986, Alan Lindauer and Bruce Beenken & Family were added.

The last entry on the hand written roster is John & Faye Reid, Members #17, who joined on Feb. 4, 1986. While many of the members were listed as" & Family", Faye Reid was the first female to attend the meetings and take an active part in the meetings and activities.

Another roster dated 1986-87 lists several additional members making the number of club members as 24.

Dues were \$6.00 per year for individuals and \$7.00 for Family Membership.

The 1990 Membership Roster, dated Jan. 1, 1990 has 41 members listed. Eighteen of the earlier members have already dropped out.

The 1991 Membership Roster, dated Jan. 1, 1991 lists only 37 members out of a total of 65 that had joined, a loss of 28.
